What is the role of a Library Board Member?

Board members bridge the gap between the library and the community, ensuring the library fulfills community needs and progresses accordingly. Membership on the Library Board is open to citizens aged 18 and above who are passionate about serving their community. They are volunteers who serve the community with no financial compensation.

What are the qualifications?

- 1. Understanding the needs, values, and dynamics of the community.
- 2. Commitment to dedicating personal time and skills for the benefit of the library.
- 3. Capability to analyze situations, make informed decisions, and consider various perspectives.
- 4. Question Objectively: Critical thinking to ask relevant and unbiased questions.
- 5. Effective communication and teamwork abilities.

What are the meeting requirements?

The Library meets once per month on the third Thursday at 6:30 pm for no more than two hours. Board member terms run for three years and members can be re-appointed for up to two additional, three year terms.
